Errata Description

The following is a known problem in revision **R and prior** of the AT89S8253 in SPI communication:

During a master-slave SPI communication, whenever the \overline{SS} input pin of the AT89S8253 acting as the slave device is pulled high during a transmission cycle, the internal SPI bit counter of the (slave) AT89S8253 does not get reset. If \overline{SS} goes high during a data transfer, all subsequent data will be corrupted in the slave. If \overline{SS} goes high in between transfers, the data remains unaffected.

Workarounds:

1. Perform a hardware reset.

or

2. Clear and then set the SPE bit in the SPCR register of the (slave) AT89S8253.
